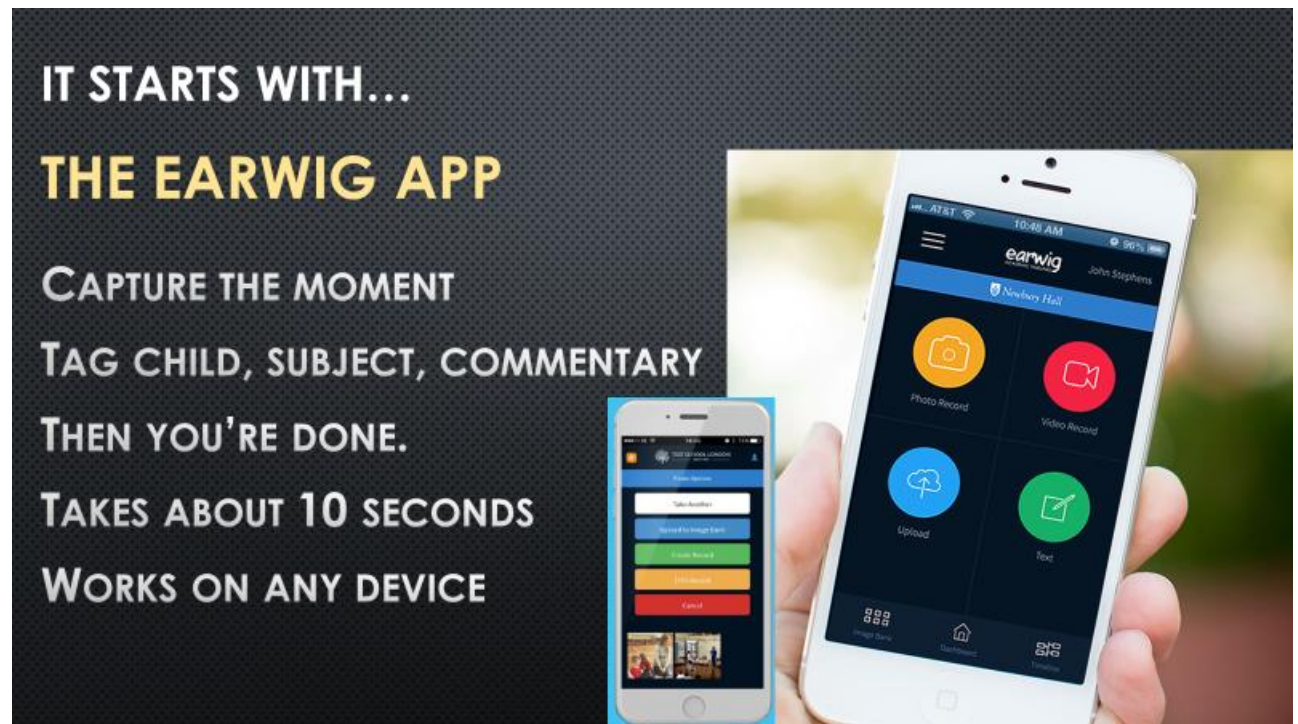


The most time-consuming element of the whole Earwig process is the capturing and managing of the evidence. That's why Earwig has created an app designed to allow you to do this as fast as possible – on most Android or iOS devices.



The app only does one thing – it creates Earwig records, quickly and simply. That's it!

Anything else that you want to do in Earwig, you do on the website.

Your school technical support should have already installed the app onto the school devices. If not, you can do it yourself. Just type 'Earwig Academic' into your app store.

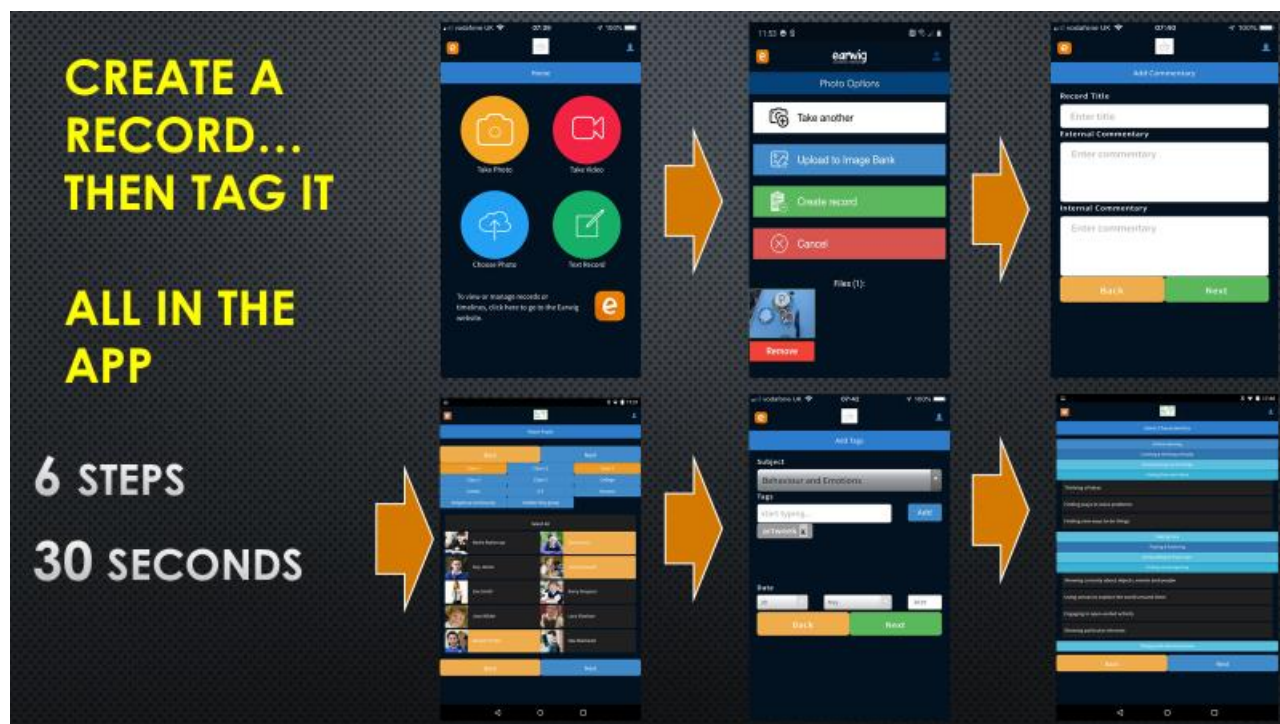
The starting screen looks like this. Four big buttons again, choose one, depending on what you are going to use to create your Earwig record.

Yellow to take a photo

Red to record a video

Blue to upload a photo, video or document from your device

Green to create a text record. Records don't have to include media.



Then it's the same sequence as creating a record online.

Once you have taken your image you have three choices. You can take another, or you can just send the image or video straight to the Image Bank to deal with later. Because Earwig is in the cloud, you can access it from anywhere, any time. So, many teachers take the photos and video in class, send these to the Image Bank and deal with them in a batch later.

But very often you, or your TA, will just take the pic and move on to create the record straight away. This means adding a title and the commentary. Then you tag the record with

- 1 The pupils
- 2 The subject and other school tags
- 3 The relevant assessment targets or statements.

Hit Publish, and you're done.

Depending on how long it takes you to write your commentary, the whole process should take about 30 seconds. If you prefer, you can hit a little microphone icon on your device keyboard and dictate your commentary. The system will turn it into text pretty accurately.
